### NOTIFICATION

GSR- .In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (5) of Article 148 of the Constitution, the President, after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and in supersession of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department (Senior Auditor) Recruitment Rules 1985, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, hereby makes the following rules to regulate the method of recruitment in the field offices of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department to the posts of Senior Auditor, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement:-** (1) These rules may be called the Indian Audit and Accounts Department (Senior Auditor) Recruitment Rules, 2020.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Application-** These rules shall be applicable to the post specified in Column (1) of Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.** - The number of posts, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
4. **Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc.-** The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said schedule.
5. **Disqualifications-** No person,-
  - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
  - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:  
Provided that the Comptroller and Auditor General of India may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
6. **Power to relax:-** Where the Comptroller and Auditor General of India is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. **Saving-** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of India from time to time in this regard.

### NOTIFICATION

GSR- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (5) of article 148 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department, (Senior Accountant) Recruitment Rules 1988, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President, after consultation with the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment in the field offices of the Indian Audit and Accounts Department to the post of Senior Accountant namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement-** (1) These rules may be called the Indian Audit and Accounts Department (Senior Accountant) Recruitment Rules, 2020.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Application-** These rules shall be applicable to the post specified in Column (1) of Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.** - The number of posts, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
4. **Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications etc.-** The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said schedule.
5. **Disqualifications-** No person,-
  - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
  - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Comptroller and Auditor General of India may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax-** Where the Comptroller and Auditor General of India is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. **Saving-** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of India from time to time in this regard as applicable to persons employed in the Indian Audit and Accounts Department.
